**GREAT NORTH ROAD, NEWARK ON TRENT - PROPOSED 'NO WAITING' RESTRICTIONS
(TRO 3360) – RE-CONSULTATION**

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. Concerns have been raised about inconsiderate and obstructive parking along Great North Road, Newark on Trent. This reduces visibility and access for drivers and pedestrians using this road. To address this issue, it is therefore proposed to introduce double yellow lines ('No Waiting At Any Time') restrictions along the length of this road as shown on drawing number H/JW/4074/02.

The consultation for the proposed 'No Waiting' restrictions was previously sent out during October 2022. The consultation process requires that the speed limit is sealed and brought into force within 2 years of the scheme being advertised but unfortunately this has not taken place. Therefore, the scheme is being re-consulted, there are no changes to the previous consultation.

Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **14th August 2025**. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
