

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GONALSTON LANE, GONALSTON AND HOVERINGHAM) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (3361B)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Gonalston and Hoveringham in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) on Gonalston Lane, Hoveringham:-

GONALSTON LANE, GONALSTON (the north-east side)

• from a point 260 metres south-east of the centre line of the Nottingham to Newark railway in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 345 metres.

GONALSTON LANE (HOVERINGHAM) (the south-west side)

• from a point 260 metres south-east of the centre line of the Nottingham to Newark railway in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 380 metres.

The double yellow lines have been installed to remove parked vehicles from Gonalston Lane, especially from the grass verges. The removal of parked vehicles would make it safer for drivers using Hoveringham Lane and would reduce the damage to the verges. The existing informal parking areas are still available for parking.
