

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SOUTHWELL ROAD, FARNSFIELD) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2024 (3370)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Farnsfield in the District of Newark and Sherwood in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule 1 of this Order shall be a Restricted Road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

SOUTHWELL ROAD, FARNSFIELD

- From a point 39 metres north-west of the north-western kerb line of its junction with Esam Close in a south-easterly direction for 19 metres
- 2. The length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order shall have a speed limit of 30mph

SOUTHWELL ROAD, FARNSFIELD

• From a point 20 metres north-west of the north-western kerb line of its junction with Esam Close in a south-easterly direction to a point 45 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerbline of Esam Close.

THIS ORDER WILL COME INTO FORCE ON 5th FEBRUARY 2024.

The 30 mph Speed Limit replaces the existing National Speed Limit (60mph) and ensures that the speed limit reflects the character of the road.
