

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A614, BLYTH ROAD, WHITEMOOR FARM,
PERLETHORPE) (PROPOSED AUTHORISED VEHICLES ONLY) TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER 2025 (3397)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Perlethorpe in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. **Authorised Vehicles Only Parking Bay** along the following lengths of road: -

A614 BLYTH ROAD, PERLETHORPE
(the east side)

- From a point 36 metres north of the access road to the Polo Club in a northerly direction for 19 metres
- From a point 53 metres south of the access road to the Polo Club in a southerly direction for 15 metres
