**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended; the effect of which will be, in relation to Crew Lane Close, Southwell in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. **To prohibit vehicles other than pedal cycles from driving on**

**Crew Lane Close, Southwell**

From its junction with Easthorpe in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Crew Lane
