

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HANDLEY COURT, NEWARK ON TRENT)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER 2026 (3410)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Newark on Trent in the District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. **Prohibition of Waiting Mon – Fri 11am - 2pm** along the following lengths of road: -

Handley Court, Newark on Trent (north-east and south-east side)

- From a point 24 metres north-west of its junction with North Gate in a north-westerly then north-easterly direction for 39 metres.

2. To provide **2 hours parking, No Return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Friday 9am – 5pm** along the following length of road: -

Handley Court, Newark on Trent (north-east side)

- From a point 12 metres north-west of its junction with North Gate in a north-westerly direction for 12 metres.

Handley Court, Newark on Trent (south-east side)

- From a point 26 metres south-west of its junction with Water Lane in a south-westerly direction for 13 metres.
