<u>HAMILTON ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD – PROPOSED 'NO WAITING' RESTRICTION (TRO 4320) AND 20MPH SPEED LIMIT (TRO 4317) – STAGE 2 CONSULTATION</u>

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. Nottinghamshire County Council has been successful in securing funding from the Government's Active Travel Fund for improvements to Hamilton Road between Coxmoor Road and Newark Road. The works will include carriageway and footway resurfacing and improvements such as new dropped kerbs. The route is currently subject to drainage issues, which will be addressed as part of the scheme by providing better kerbing to channel surface water, and additional surface water drains, subject to approval from Severn Trent Water. On-street parking bays and existing lining will be formalised, a short stretch of single-yellow line (**No Waiting Monday to Saturday 9am – 5pm**) introduced to help traffic flow along the route and new double yellow lines laid in the turning head. The scheme also includes a proposal to reduce the speed limit to 20mph to provide a better environment for pedestrians and cyclists. The proposals are detailed on the enclosed plans H/CLW/5184/01 and H/CLW/5074/01.

The County Council secured funding to deliver the scheme through the Active Travel Fund, the funding can only be used for schemes which look to encourage active travel such as walking, wheeling and cycling. This scheme also encompasses the County Council's 'whole road' approach and therefore the proposed improvements will benefit all Highway users.

Nottinghamshire County Council have secured funding to deliver the scheme through the Active Travel Fund. The proposals are to reduce the existing speed limit to 20-mph on a section of Hamilton Road, between B6022 Newark Road and B6139 Coxmoor Road, Limes Close and Dukes Close, Sutton in Ashfield in order to improve road safety. An assessment of the existing speed limit has been carried out and it has been confirmed that the section of Hamilton Road, Limes Court and Dukes Close, Sutton in Ashfield are suitable to reduce to 20 mph limit.

Further to the stage one consultation letter of 22nd July 2025, the next stage of the consultation is to publicly advertise the scheme. The notice will be published in the Mansfield and Ashfield Chad and notices will be fixed on site. A plan showing the proposals is attached (Drawing Number H/CLW/5184/01 and H/CLW/5074/01) along with a copy of the site notices.

Any objections should clearly state the reasons for the objections and should reach us in writing, either by letter or email, by **22**nd **October 2025**. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
