

The Nottinghamshire County Council
(Mill Croft and Silk Street, Sutton-in-Ashfield)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (4198)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following : -

MILL CROFT, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (both sides)

- from its junction with Silk Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 metres

SILK STREET, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (the west side)

- from a point 6 metres north of its junction with Mill Croft in a southerly direction to a point 6 metres south of that junction
