

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Forest Road, Salmon Lane and Skegby Road, Annesley Woodhouse) (Prohibition of Waiting and Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (4200)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Annesley Woodhouse in the District of Ashfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following: -

FOREST ROAD, (ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE) (the north side)

from its junction with Skegby Road in an easterly direction for 16 metres.

SALMON LANE, (ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE) (the north side)

• from its junction with Skegby Road in a westerly direction for 17 metres.

SKEGBY ROAD (ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE) (the east side)

• from its junction with Forest Road in a northerly direction for 13 metres.

SKEGBY ROAD (ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE) (the west side)

- from its junction with Forest Road in a northerly direction for 12 metres.
- 2. **Parking bays.** All vehicles Monday to Friday, 9am-5pm **2 hours parking** with no return within 1 hour

FOREST ROAD (ANNESLEY WOODHOUSE) the north side

- from a point 16 metres east of its junction with Skegby Road in an easterly direction for 25 metres.
- from a point 56 metres west of its junction with Reform Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
