

## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

### **The Nottinghamshire County Council (North Street, Huthwaite) (Revocation of Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (4258)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Huthwaite in the District of Ashfield: -

To revoke the existing No Waiting Mon - Sat 8 am – 6 pm restrictions (Single Yellow Lines) at the following locations: -

North Street, Huthwaite (the east side)

From a point 41 metres north of its junction with Duke Street in a northerly direction for 37 metres

North Street, Huthwaite (the west side)

From a point 55 metres north of its junction with High Street in a northerly direction for 30 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
