

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Beardall Street and Croft Avenue, Hucknall) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (4274)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respect of roads at Hucknall in the District of Ashfield: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Beardall Street, Hucknall (the south-west side)

- From a point 2 metres north-west of its junction with Croft Avenue in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.

Croft Avenue, Hucknall (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Beardall Street in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres.

Croft Avenue, Hucknall (the south-east side)

- From its junction with Beardall Street in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres.
