

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GILL STREET, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (4282)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Gill Street, Sutton in Ashfield (the east side)

- From the junction with Alfreton Road in a northerly direction for 13 metres.

Gill Street, Sutton in Ashfield (the west side)

- From the junction with Alfreton Road in a northerly direction for 14 metres.
