

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PARK STREET, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD) (PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' CONTROLLED ZONE) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (4294)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

- 1. **Residents' Parking Scheme** on **Monday to Saturday between 9am and 5pm** along the following length of road: -
- (i) PARK STREET (both sides)
  - From a point 9 metres north-west of its junction with Outram Street in a north-westerly direction to a point 12 metres south-east of its north-west extremity.
