TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (4305)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kirkby in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield: -

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Orchard Road, Kirkby in Ashfield (the east side)

- From its junction with B6020 Chapel Street for 13 metres in a southerly direction.

Orchard Road, Kirkby in Ashfield (the west side)

- From its junction with B6020 Chapel Street for 11 metres in a southerly direction.
