

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BRAND LANE AND NEW LANE, STANTON HILL, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (4308)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Stanton Hill, Sutton in Ashfield in the Ashfield District: -

Proposed prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Brand Lane, Stanton Hill, Sutton in Ashfield (the north-west side)

From its junction with B6028 High Street in a south-westerly direction for 26 metres.

Brand Lane, Stanton Hill, Sutton in Ashfield (the south-east side)

• From its junction with B6028 Stoneyford Road in a south-westerly direction for 30 metres.

New Lane, Stanton Hill, Sutton in Ashfield (the north-west side)

• From its junction with B6028 High Street in a north-easterly direction for 20 metres.

New Lane, Stanton Hill, Sutton in Ashfield (the south-east side)

From its junction with B6028 Stoneyford Road in a north-easterly direction for 15 metres.
