

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6019 KIRKBY LANE, PINXTON) (PROPOSED 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (4314)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Pinxton in the District of Ashfield in the County of Nottinghamshire:-

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.
- 2. The following Orders are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the lengths of road stated in the Schedule to this Order.
 - NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BUILT UP AREAS) (NO.1) ORDER 1958
- 3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

B6019 KIRKBY LANE, PINXTON

• From a point 41 metres south-west of the western kerbline of Langton Hall Access Road in a southwesterly direction to a point 38 metres south-west of the south-western property boundary of Brookside an approximate distance of 665 metres.
