NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Annesley in the District of Ashfield in the County of Nottinghamshire: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

SCHEDULE

A608 MANSFIELD ROAD, ANNESLEY

- From its junction with the A611 Annesley Road/Derby Road Roundabout in a south-westerly then westerly direction to its junction with M1 Jct 27 Roundabout.
