

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HAMILTON ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD) (20 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2025 (4317) AND (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2025 (4320)

Statement of Reasons

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services.

Nottinghamshire County Council has been successful in securing funding from the Government's Active Travel Fund for improvements to Hamilton Road between Coxmoor Road and Newark Road. The works will include carriageway and footway resurfacing and improvements such as new dropped kerbs. The route is currently subject to drainage issues, which will be addressed as part of the scheme by providing better kerbing to channel surface water, and additional surface water drains, subject to approval from Severn Trent Water. On-street parking bays and existing lining will be formalised, a short stretch of single-yellow line (No Waiting Monday to Saturday 9am – 5pm) introduced to help traffic flow along the route and new double yellow lines laid in the turning head. The scheme also includes a proposal to reduce the speed limit to 20mph to provide a better environment for pedestrians and cyclists. The proposals are detailed on the enclosed plans H/CLW/5184/01 and H/CLW/5074/01.
