

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6021 LOWMOOR ROAD, KIRBY IN ASHFIELD) (PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC REGULATION (ORDER) 2025 (4321)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No 1086 as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kirkby in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

1. To provide 1 hour parking, No Return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 8 am - 6 pm. Along the following length of road: -

B6021 Lowmoor Road, Kirkby in Ashfield (the south-west side)

From a point 7 metres north-west of its junction with Portland Street in a north-westerly direction for 15 metres
