

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Banks Road and Seaburn Road, Toton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (5237)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Toton in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along : -

Banks Road - (north-west side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Seaburn Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 9 metres north-east of that junction

Banks Road - (south-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 4.5 metres south-west of its junction with Seaburn Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 7 metres

Seaburn Road (both sides)

- From its junction with Banks Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres
