

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Brookhill Street Area, Stapleford)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 (5238)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Stapleford in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

In order to prevent vehicles from parking at the junctions which is causing obstructions and issues with visibility, vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along :-

Ash Grove (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 8 metres

Blake Road (both sides) – from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 15 metres

Brookhill Street (the north- west side)

- from a point opposite a point 8 metres south-west of its junction with New Eaton Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 23 metres

- from its junction with Toton Lane in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres

Brookhill Street (south-east side)

- 8 metres either side its junction with Ash Grove

- from a point 8 metres south-west of its junction with New Eaton Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 17 metres north-east of that junction

- 8 metres either side of its junction with Hawthorne Avenue

- 8 metres either side of its junction with Linden Grove

- 8 metres either side of its junction with Myrtle Avenue

- 8 metres either side of its junction with Newton Drive

- 8 metres either side of its junction with Portland Crescent

- from its junction with Toton Lane for a distance of 33 metres

Hawthorne Avenue (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 6 metres

Linden Grove (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 9 metres

Myrtle Avenue (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 6 metres

Newton Drive (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 6 metres

New Eaton Road (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 9 metres

Portland Crescent (both sides) - from its junction with Brookhill Street for a distance of 8 metres

Toton Lane (north east side) - From a point 7 metres north-west of its junction with Blake Road in a south-easterly direction to a point 18 metres south-east of that junction

Toton Lane (south east side) - from a point 13 metres north-west of its junction with Brookhill Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 19 metres south-east of that junction
