

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Walker Street, Eastwood)  
(Prohibition of Waiting and No Stopping on Entrance Clearways) Traffic  
Regulation Order 2017 (5245)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Eastwood in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

**Walker Street - (north-west side)**

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting Monday to Friday 8am – 4.30pm : -  
  
from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Lynncroft in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 140 metres.
2. Vehicles will be prohibited from stopping on school entrance markings on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm at the following locations :-  
  
from a point 150 metres south-west of its junction with Lynncroft in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 64 metres.  
  
from a point opposite a point 19 metres south-west of its junction with Percy Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 37 metres

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref. **5245**) must be received by me by **the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 2017**.

The no waiting restriction is required to keep one side of the road clear for vehicles to pass safely. The no stopping restrictions are to be applied to the school keep clear markings outside the school to prohibit stopping during the school day.
