<u>THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> <u>(AWSWORTH LANE AND MAWS LANE, KIMBERLEY)</u> <u>(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018 (5249)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

AWSWORTH LANE, KIMBERLEY (the north - west side)

From its junction with Eastwood Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres (existing restriction 33 metres)

MAWS LANE, KIMBERLEY (the south-east side)

From its junction with Eastwood Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 34 metres (existing restriction 15 metres)
