

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council (Orchard Street, Kimberley) (Parking Places and Residents' Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (5266)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

- 1. To provide residents' parking places operating Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm along Orchard Street, Kimberley (south-east side)
 - from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 16 metres
 - from a point 35 metres north-east of its junction with Main Street in a north-easterly direction for 36 metres
- 2. To provide 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 8am 6pm along: -

Orchard Street (the south-east side)

- from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 16 metres
- 3. Vehicles will be prevented from parking Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm along: -

Orchard Street (the south-east side) -

• from a point 26 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres

Written comments / objections (stating grounds and quoting ref. **5266**) must be received by me by **1**st **day November 2019.**

The provision is required to improve parking facilities for residents by removing non-residential parked vehicles from the south-western end of Orchard Street, Kimberley. Non-resident parking at the north-eastern end will be allowed for up to 2 hours.

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
