The Nottinghamshire County Council (Orchard Street, Kimberley) (Parking Places and Residents' Controlled Zone) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5266)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes **has made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

- 1. To provide residents' parking places operating Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm along Orchard Street, Kimberley (south-east side) –
- from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 12 metres
- from a point 37 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 8 metres
- from a point 50 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south-westerly direction for 24 metres
- 2. To provide 2 hours parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 8am 6pm along: -

Orchard Street (the south-east side)

 from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Main Street in a south- westerly direction for 12 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
