

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MEADOWBANK WAY, EASTWOOD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019 (5270)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Eastwood in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

Meadowbank Way, Eastwood – north-south section (both sides)

 From a point 20 metres north of the eastern section in a southerly direction to a point 20 metres south of that junction

MEADOWBANK WAY, EASTWOOD (West Section) (both sides)

- From its junction with Meadowbank Way (north-south section) in a westerly direction for 16 metres
- 2. To provide 1 hour parking, no return within 1 hour. Operating Monday to Saturday 7am 5pm :-

MEADOWBANK WAY, EASTWOOD (East Section)(the north side)

• From a point 13 metres east of the north-east section in an easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres
