

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Assarts Road, Drummond Drive and Temple Drive, Nuthall (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (5273)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Nuthall in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prevented from waiting At Any Time at the following: -

**DRUMMOND DRIVE**, (both sides) - from its junction with Temple Drive in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres (measured along the centre line of the road)

**TEMPLE DRIVE** (the south-east side) - from a point 8 metres north-east of its junction with Drummond Drive in a south-westerly direction to a point 8 metres south-west of that junction

2. Vehicles will be prevented from waiting Monday to Friday 8am-9.30 am and 3pm - 4.30pm at the following: -

**ASSARTS ROAD** (the north-east side) – from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Vernon Drive in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Carters Wood Drive

**TEMPLE DRIVE**

(the north-west side) - from a point opposite a point 8 metres north-east of its junction with Drummond Drive in a south-westerly direction for 48 metres

(the south-east side) - from a point 8 metres south-west of its junction with Drummond Drive in a south-westerly direction for 25 metres

(the south-west side) - from a point 48 metres south-west of its junction with Drummond Drive in a north-westerly direction for 5 metres
