

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Abbey Drive and Abbey Road,
Beeston) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2019 (5275)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

ABBEY DRIVE, BEESTON – both sides

From its junction with Abbey Road, in a north-westerly direction for 6 metres

ABBEY ROAD, BEESTON - (the north-west side)

From a point 12 metres south-west of its junction with Abbey Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point 12 metres north-east of that junction.
