

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Forge Hill, Hallams Lane, High Road,
Hurts Croft, The Close and Woodland Grove, Chilwell)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5279)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Chilwell in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along: -

FORGE HILL, CHILWELL (the north-east side)

- From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

FORGE HILL, CHILWELL (the south-west side)

- From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

HALLAMS LANE, CHILWELL

- (the north-east side) From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 22 metres
- (the south-east side) From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Hurts Croft in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction
- (the south-west side) From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 18 metres

HIGH ROAD, CHILWELL

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Hallams Lane in an easterly direction for 9 metres

(the north-west side)

- From a point 15 metres south-west of the centre line of its junction with Forge Hill in a north-easterly direction to a point 15 metres north-east of the centre line of that junction
- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with The Close in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction
- From its junction with Hallams Lane in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres
- From a point 11 metres south-west of its junction with Woodland Grove in a north-easterly direction to a point 11 metres north-east of that junction

HURTS CROFT, CHILWELL

(the north-east side)

- From a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with The Close in a north-westerly direction to a point 10 metres north-west of that junction
 - From its junction with Hallams Lane in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres
- (the north-west side)
- From its junction with The Close in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres
- (the south-east side)
- From its junction with The Close in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres
- (the south-west side)
- From its junction with Hallams Lane in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres

THE CLOSE, CHILWELL

- (the north-east side) From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres
- (the north-west side) From its junction with Hurts Croft in a north-easterly direction for 10 metres
- (the south-east side) From its junction with Hurts Croft in a north-easterly direction for 10 metres (the south-west side)
- From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres
- From a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Hurts Croft in a north-westerly direction to a point 10 metres north-west of that junction

WOODLAND GROVE, CHILWELL (both sides)

- From its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 11 metres

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting Mon – Fri 8.30 am to 4.30 pm** along: -

FORGE HILL, CHILWELL (the south-west side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with High Road in a north-westerly direction for 83 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
