

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (The Lane, Awsworth) (Revocation of
Parking Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5284)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Awsworth in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

To revoke the existing 1-hour parking Mon - Sat 8 am – 6 pm restrictions at the following location: -

The Lane, Awsworth (the west side)

From a point 19 metres north of its junction with Middleton Street in a northerly direction for 12 metres

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The 1-hour parking restrictions are to be removed as the local shops have closed and are no longer required and to allow unrestricted parking for residents.
