

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council
(Knowle Hill and Nottingham Road, Kimberley)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (5286)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting **at any time** along: -

KNOWLE HILL, KIMBERLEY

- (the north-west side) - From its junction with Nottingham Road in a south-westerly direction for 17 metres
- (the south-east side) - From its junction with Nottingham Road in a south-westerly direction for 26 metres

NOTTINGHAM ROAD, KIMBERLEY

- (the north-east side) - From a point opposite a point 8 metres north-west of its junction with Knowle Hill in a south-easterly direction for 38 metres
- (the south-west side) - From a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Knowle Hill in a north-westerly direction to a point 15 metres north-west of that junction

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
