

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Grove Street, Beeston)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (5297)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **HAS MADE** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**Grove Street, Beeston** (the north-west side)

- From a point 10 meters south-west of its entrance with Sovereign Court in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that entrance

**Grove Street, Beeston** (the south-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 10 meters south-west of its entrance with Sovereign Court in a north-easterly direction for 25 metres.
