Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

Gladstone Street, Beeston (the north-west side)

• From a point 10 metres south-west of the centre line of its junction with Imperial Road in south-westerly direction for 3 metres.

Gladstone Street, Beeston (the south-east side)

• From a point 10 metres south-west of the centre line of its junction with Imperial Road in southwesterly direction for 6 metres.

Hall Croft, Beeston (the north-west side)

- From its junction with West End in south-westerly direction for 14 metres.
- From a point 55 metres south-west of its junction with West End in a south-westerly, then north-westerly direction for 40 metres.

Hall Croft, Beeston (the south-east side)

• From its junction with West End in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres

West End, Beeston (the east side)

• From a point 108 metres south-west of its junction with Dovecote Lane in a south-easterly direction for 23 metres.

West End, Beeston (the west side)

• From its junction with Hall Croft in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres.
