

<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council</u> (Dovecote Lane Area, Beeston) (Prohibition of Waiting and Parking Places) <u>Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (5303)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting At Any Time along: -

DOVECOTE LANE, BEESTON

(the north-east side)

• From a point 23 metres south-east of its junction with Barton Street in a south-easterly direction for 40 metres

• From a point 85 metres south-east of its junction with Barton Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with New Road 1 (the south-west side)

 From a point opposite a point 35 metres south-east of its junction with Barton Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with New Road 1

NEW ROAD 1, BEESTON

(the north-west side)

- From its junction with Dovecote Lane in a southerly then south-westerly direction for 38 metres
- From a point 10 metres north-east of the northern junction with Road Number 2 in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres southwest of that junction
- From a point 10 metres north-east of the southern junction with Road Number 2 in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres southwest of that junction
- From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Road Number 3 in a south-westerly direction to a point 10 metres south-west of that junction
- From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with the turning head in a south-westerly direction to its south-western extremity, including the turning head

(the south-east side)

• From its junction with Dovecote Lane in a south-westerly direction to its south-western extremity including its south-western extremity

NEW ROAD 2, BEESTON

(the east side)

• From a point 43 metres north-west of its southern junction with New Road 1 in a westerly direction for 20 metres

(the northern section north-east side)

• From its junction with New Road 1 in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres (the northern section south-west side)

From its junction with New Road 1 in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

(the south side)

• From a point 43 metres north-west of its northern junction with New Road 1 in a westerly direction for 20 metres (the southern junction north-east side)

• From its junction with New Road 1 in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

(the southern junction south-west side)

• From its junction with New Road 1 in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres

NEW ROAD 3, BEESTON (both sides)

- From its junction with New Road 1 in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres
- 2. To provide 2-hours parking, No return within 1 hour. Operating Mon Sat 8am 6pm along the following length of road: -

DOVECOTE LANE, BEESTON (the north-east side)

• From a point 63 metres south-east of its junction with Barton Street in a south-easterly direction for 22 metres
