NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Chilwell in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

BRAMCOTE LANE, CHILWELL (the west side)

• from its junction with Field Lane in a northerly direction for 14 metres

FIELD LANE, CHILWELL (the north side)

• From its junction with School Lane in a westerly direction for 26 metres

FIELD LANE, CHILWELL (the south side)

• From its junction with School Lane in a westerly direction for 16 metres

SCHOOL LANE, CHILWELL (the west side)

- From its junction with Field Lane in a southerly direction for 19 metres
- 2. Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting Mon to Fri 8am 6 pm** along the following length of road:

FIELD LANE, CHILWELL (the south side)

• From a point 16 metres west of its junction with School Lane in a westerly direction for 8 metres
