(the south-east side)

• From its junction with Station Road in a north-easterly direction to its north-eastern extremity

(north-east side - south-east to north-west section)

• From its junction with Locomotive Way north-west side in a north-westerly direction to its north-western extremity

(south-west side - south-east to north-west section

• From its junction with Locomotive Way north-west side in a north-westerly direction to its north-western extremity (including its north-eastern extremity)

STATION ROAD, BEESTON

(the south-west side and south-eastern extremity)

- From its junction with Locomotive Way in a south-westerly then north-westerly direction for 10 metres
