

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Gilt Hill and Gilt Hill Slip Road,
Kimberley) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021 (5306)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting and Loading At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

GILT HILL, KIMBERLEY (SLIP ROAD)

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a south-easterly direction for 125 metres

(the south-west side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a south-easterly direction for 97 metres

GILT HILL, KIMBERLEY (Nottingham bound)

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road (Ikea Roundabout) in a south-easterly direction for 199 metres

(the south-west side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road (Ikea Roundabout) in a south-easterly direction for 79 metres

GILT HILL, KIMBERLEY (Giltbrook bound)

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road (Ikea Roundabout) in a south-easterly direction for 77 metres

(the south-west side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road (Ikea Roundabout) in a south-easterly direction for 180 metres
