

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Derbyshire Avenue, Trowell) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 (5308)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Trowell in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

DERBYSHIRE AVENUE, TROWELL

(the north-eastern turning head)

• From a point 2.5 metres north-east of the boundary line between numbers 29/31 around the entire turning head for 41 metres
