Proposed changes to Parking Restrictions

CITY ROAD, BEESTON - PUBLIC ADVERT

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver Highway Services.

Nottinghamshire County Council have received complaints regarding the existing layout and parking provisions on City Road, Beeston. Users have expressed concern that the gap between parking spaces for non-motorised users is too narrow. The lack of dropped kerbs on the adjacent footway means that wheelchair/pushchair users and cyclists must squeeze through this narrow gap and travel in the road until they reach dropped kerbs.

In response to these concerns, Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to modify the existing scheme to improve access for these users.

The proposals are shown on the attached drawing H/ SLW/3709/04 and comprise of :-

- Remove 2 parking spaces and extend Double Yellow Lines on the south-west side of the road
- Remove Double Yellow Lines outside 21/23 and replace with 1 new resident parking space
- New dropped kerbs to allow access for cyclists, pushchairs and wheelchair users
