

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SALTHOUSE LANE, BEESTON) (AMENDMENTS TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (5312)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Salthouse Lane, Beeston - the south-west side

- 1. Vehicles will be Prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following: -
 - from a point 83 metres north-west of its junction with Broadgate in a northwesterly direction for 10 metres
 - from a point 123 metres north-west of its junction with Broadgate in a northwesterly direction for 20 metres
- 2. To provide 2-hour parking places, no return within 1 hour, Mon Fri 8 am 4.30pm, at the following:
 - from a point 9 metres north-west of its junction with Broadgate in a north-westerly direction for 74 metres
 - from a point 94 metres north-west of its junction with Broadgate in a north-westerly direction for 30 metres
 - from a point 143 metres north-west of its junction with Broadgate in a north-westerly direction for 62 metres
