

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EDWARD ROAD AND
NOTTINGHAM ROAD, EASTWOOD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC
REGULATION ORDER 2023 (5320)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Eastwood in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

Edward Road, Eastwood (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Three Tuns Road.

Edward Road, Eastwood (the south-east side)

- From its junction with Nottingham Road in a north-easterly direction for 9 metres.

Nottingham Road, Eastwood (the north-east side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Edward Road in a south-easterly direction to a point 12 metres south-east of this junction.
