

# THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (AMBLESIDE DRIVE, COPPICE DRIVE AND FERN CRESCENT, EASTWOOD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (5328)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Eastwood in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

## **Ambleside Drive, Eastwood** (both sides)

• From its junction with Coppice Drive in a north-westerly direction for 10 metres.

### <u>Coppice Drive</u>, <u>Eastwood</u> (north-west side)

• From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Ambleside Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point 12 metres north-east of that junction.

### **Coppice Drive, Eastwood** (south-east side)

• From From a point 22 metres south-west of the centreline of its junction with Fern Crescent in a north-easterly direction to a point 19 metres north-east of the centreline of that junction.

#### Fern Crescent, Eastwood (both sides)

 From its junction with Coppice Drive in a south-easterly direction for 13 metres.(measured along the centreline
