PROPOSED 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT (TRO 5329) - PUBLIC ADVERT

Via East Midlands Ltd is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services.

The county council has received requests to extend the existing 30mph Speed Limit along a section of the A6005 Queens Road West, Beeston, between Dovecote Lane and Meadow Lane, due to changes in the character of the road, brought about by recent developments. An assessment has been carried out, which confirms that the section detailed above is suitable for a 30 mph speed limit and is being considered as part of a package of measures to improve the existing cycle route along this corridor.

The proposals will be advertised, and notices displayed on site. A plan showing the extents of the proposed 30mph Speed Limit is attached (Drawing Number H/SLW/4215/01) along with a copy of the site notice.

Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **5**th **April 2023**. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals, please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
