(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026
(5331)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of roads: -

Digby Street, Kimberley (north-west side)

- From its junction with Gilt Hill in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres.

Digby Street, Kimberley (south-east side)

- From its junction with Gilt Hill in a south-westerly direction for 11 metres.

Gilt Hill, Kimberley (south-west side)

- From a point 19 metres north-west of its junction with Digby Street in a south-easterly direction to a point 10 metres south-east of that junction.
