**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A6002 COVENTRY
LANE, BRAMCOTE) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024 (5322)**

The Council of the County of Nottinghamshire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-



1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of roads specified in the Schedule of this Order.
2. The following Order is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the lengths of road specified in the schedule to this Order "THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A6002 COVENTRY LANE, BRAMCOTE) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017 (5244)".
3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as "THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A6002 COVENTRY LANE, BRAMCOTE) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024 (5322)" and shall come into force on **31st October 2024**.

A6002 Coventry Lane, Bramcote, in the Borough of Broxtowe from a point 55 metres north-east of its north-eastern-most junction with Longden Close in a north-easterly direction to a point 274 metres south-west of its junction with Sharnford Way
