

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KNOWLE LANE AND
SWINGATE, KIMBERLEY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (5333)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Kimberley in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

Proposed **Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

KNOWLE LANE, KIMBERLEY (the north-west side)

- From a point 92 metres south-west of its junction with Clive Crescent in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Swingate.

SWINGATE, KIMBERLEY (the north-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 12 metres south-east of the southern kerb line of West Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Knowle Lane.
