

<u>THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (ASSARTS ROAD, NUTHALL) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS) <u>TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (5334)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Nuthall in the Borough of Broxtowe:

Vehicles will be **<u>Prohibited from Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 9.30 am and 3 pm - 4.30pm</u> along the following length of road: -**

ASSARTS ROAD, NUTHALL

(the north-east side)

- From a point 28 metres south-east of its junction with Drummond Drive in a south-easterly direction for 31 metres
- From a point 13 metres south-east of its junction with Horsendale Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 57 metres
