

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BANKS ROAD, GOODWOOD DRIVE, SANDOWN ROAD AND SEABURN ROAD, TOTON) (NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS & PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (5338)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Toton in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be **Prohibited from Stopping Mon – Fri 8am – 4.30pm** along the following lengths of road: -

BANKS ROAD, TOTON

(the north-west side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Seaburn Road in a south-westerly direction for 37 metres
- From a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Seaburn Road in a north-easterly direction for 62 metres

(the south-east side)

- From a point 9 metres north-east of its junction with Goodwood Drive in a north-easterly direction for 154 metres

2. Vehicles will be **Prohibited from Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road:-

BANKS ROAD, TOTON

(the north-west side)

- From a point 12 metres south-west of its junction with Sandown Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction

(the south-east side)

- From a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Goodwood Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point 9 metres north-east of that junction

GOODWOOD DRIVE, TOTON

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Banks Road in a south-easterly direction for 9 metres

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Banks Road in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres

SANDOWN ROAD, TOTON

(the north-east side)

- From its junction with Banks Road in a north-westerly direction for 15 metres

(the south-west side)

- From its junction with Banks Road in a north-westerly direction for 15 metres

SEABURN ROAD, TOTON (the north-east side)

- From a point 12 metres north-west of its junction with Banks Road in a north-westerly direction for 15 metres
