

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (COW LANE AND HILLSIDE ROAD, BRAMCOTE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (5345)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Bramcote in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Prohibition from Waiting At Any Time along the following length of roads: -

Cow Lane, Bramcote (south-east side)

• From a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Hillside Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 17 metres south-west of that junction.

Hillside Road, Bramcote (north-east side)

• From its junction with Cow Lane in a south-easterly direction for 10 metres.

Hillside Road, Bramcote (south-west side)

• From its junction with Cow Lane in a south-easterly direction for 11 metres.
