

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (KENILWORTH ROAD, BEESTON) (RESIDENTS' PARKING ZONES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (5356)

Statement of Reasons

Letters were sent to residents on 11th October 2023 asking whether or not you were in support of a Residents Parking Scheme (RPS). The questionnaires were sent to to 25 properties on Kenilworth Road, Beeston. There were a total of 15 questionnaires returned (60 %), 12 of these (80%) were in favour, 3 of these (20%) were are against the proposals. In order for the County Council to consider the introduction of a RPS there has to be 35% of the questionnaires returned and of these 65% must be in favour.

As the returns from the residents meets the criteria, the next stage of the process is to formally consult on the proposals to introduce a RPS which would be operation Mon – Sat 9am - 10am and 3pm - 4pm.

The proposed double yellow lines would prohibit waiting by all vehicles at all times. The proposals would remove non-resident parking from Kenilworth Road.
